



## Toonie Tournament 2017 Friday & Saturday, Dec. 8-9

### SCORING

**As this is tournament is highlighting FUN and the spirit of competition, we will be posting scores and points, but not awarding medals to teams. No tie breakers, No semi finals and No final games will be played.**

### AWARDS

Whitehorse FC wants to develop a higher standard of respect in sport, fair play, and outstanding sportsmanship, along with the importance of civil responsibility. Thus, we **will NOT be awarding individual or team medals for gold, silver or bronze for this tournament.** So, rather, we will be awarding prizes for the following:

- The team who raises the most \$\$ FUNDS
- The team who brings the most non-perishable food items
- FAIR PLAY TROPHY for the team which displays exemplary team respect, sportsmanship and fair play!

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### RULES & FORMAT

The teams have been divided into POOLS. Tournament format will be a simple round robin where each team plays the other teams within its pool once. **No semi final or final games will be played. YES, some teams will have to play back to back games** – we have tried to reduce the occurrence, so please be prepared. We have also given each team one game in the fieldhouse and flexihall.

- ALL games are 30 minutes in length; two 15 minute halves with 3 minute break
- Teams MUST wear their WFC sponsored shirts. Yes, pinnies will be used to differentiate between teams of similar colours.
- Game format is 4 v 4 plus goalie
- Games will be played in one third of the field-house or flexi-hall when at the CGC. Games at the College or other school venues will be set to accommodate the age level.
- Substitutions - up to 12 players can be used in one match and there is no limit on how long a player must stay on or off the pitch. Players must enter and leave the field of play from in front of the respective team's bench. Minimum team size is 7. Unlimited substitutions allowed.
- Kick In - in order to restart the game after a ball has gone out of play the ball is kicked back into play from the touchline and from corners. The ball must be placed stationary on the touchline and the feet of the player taking the kick-in must not cross the line.
- The Four Second rule - for kick-ins, free kicks, goal clearances and corner kicks - the player in possession of the ball has 4 seconds to restart play which the referee will count with their fingers in the air. If play isn't restarted within four seconds possession is surrendered to the opposing team. The goalkeeper is not allowed to control the ball for more than 4 seconds in his/ her own half. This rule will be relaxed for the fundamental 1&2 groups. Four seconds will be counted but players will not be penalized for going over 4 seconds.
- Five Metre Rule - players are required to keep 5m from the player in possession of the ball on free kicks, corners, goal clearances, kick-ins and penalties.
  - Goalkeepers are allowed to come out of and players are allowed to go into the penalty area.
  - A restart from the goalkeeper must be thrown out, but the goalkeeper can use their feet to distribute the ball from open play.
- REFEREES - we will schedule referees for all games, however if you end up not having a referee, please let us know at the tournament desk ASAP and we will find someone to step in. Respect the youth referees at all times.
- ZERO TOLERANCE - ANY coaches, parents, or players reported as being disrespectful to players, coaches or referees will be asked to leave the tournament immediately
